The **Irish Geological Institute** and the **European Federation of Geologists** co-organize next 15th May at the Dublin Castle a workshop on **Natural Resources Reporting**. The venue counts with renowned speakers from all over the world who will deal with the current situation of the global and European mineral industry and the pan-European code of reporting mineral resources and reserves. The workshop is today even more attractive due to the recently issues **EU Raw Materials Initiative** that addresses the rising preoccupation of the EU on a sustainable raw materials supply for Europe and is of special importance to Ireland as a class minerals European producer, home to many international mining companies.

The European Federation of Geologists (EFG), an organization representing 140 000 geologists over Europe in 21 nations, will also celebrate in Dublin its **Annual Council Meeting** from 16th to 17th May, hosted by the **Irish Institute of Geologists**. The Council will deal with the current expansion of activities and programs of the organization which is involved in several EU financed projects dealing with professional matters, and will hold elections for part of its Board. The EFG has its headquarters in Brussels and defends a common European geological policy on matters such as renewable energies, natural hazards, land-use planning and the sustainable use of natural resources.
